- Booth Space is 10'x12'. Have accurate measurement for the space you require including trailer tongues, tie-downs, awnings, tip-outs, and doors.
- Craft booth fee is \$40.
- Retail Booth fee is \$75
- Informational Booth \$20.00 (no sales)
- Food booth fee \$125.00 (professionals).
- Food vendors are responsible to abide by Health Department regulations including food permit fee. 606-573-3219.
- Vendors selling drinks must sell 16 oz or 20 oz plastic bottles unless given a variance.
- Vendors are responsible for bringing their own tents, tables and chairs.
- Vendors using electricity must have an extension cord with a minimum of 12-gauge rating.
- There is a \$50 fee for electrical usage,
- No marshmallow guns, silly string, sling shots, blow guns, bow & arrows, BB guns or poppers may be sold.
- No roving sales, No yard sale items, No lewd or obscene materials, drug paraphernalia, weapons or fake cigarettes will be sold.
- If you sell handmade crafts it must be only crafts and no retail or you will be charged a retail fee as well.
- Food vendors the festival committee reserves the right to delete items from the menu if items were not included in the application.
- We try not to have duplicate items such as specialty items fried candy bars, ice cream, etc.
- Grills or other cooking devices must be barricaded from public access by at least 4' in any direction. Please consider this when calculating your space requirements. NO DUMPING COOKING OIL, \$500.00 FINE.
- Food vendors must provide proof of insurance with your completed application.
- All vendors are responsible for the removal of trash from their space and place in the provided dumpster. Please keep your booth clean.
