Deck the Holler Christmas Tree Decorating Guidelines

1. Tree Setup and Decorations

- Participants must provide their own Christmas tree, ornaments, and all decorations. Harlan Tourism, the City of Harlan, and Harlan Little League are only providing designated space for tree setup.
- Trees must be securely staked or anchored to ensure they remain upright in case of inclement weather or strong winds. Unstaked or unstable trees may be removed at the discretion of event organizers.
- Trees and decorations must be suitable for outdoor display and weather-resistant to withstand the elements throughout the event duration.

2. Respect and Safety

- Participants are expected to be respectful of other displays. Do not touch, tamper with, or interfere with other participants' trees or decorations. If found that a participant has tampered with another participant's tree, the offender will be disqualified from winning monetary prizes.
- The area around each tree must be kept clear of obstacles and hazards to ensure the safety of all visitors to Huff Park.

3. Indemnity and Liability

- Harlan Tourism, the City of Harlan, and Harlan Little League are not responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to trees or decorations.
- By participating in Deck the Holler, you agree to indemnify and hold harmless
 Harlan Tourism, the City of Harlan, Harlan Little League, and all event organizers
 and volunteers from any claims, damages, or liabilities arising from your
 participation in the event.

4. Setup and Removal

- Tree setup must be completed within the specified dates and times provided by the event organizers. Failure to set up within this period may result in forfeiting your designated space.
- All trees and decorations must be removed promptly by the designated takedown date. Any items left behind may be discarded.

5. Additional Information

- Participants are encouraged to be creative and festive in their tree decorations, but decorations must not include any offensive, obscene, or inappropriate materials.
- Electrical lighting and power sources will not be provided. If you choose to use battery-operated lights, you are responsible for ensuring their proper use and maintenance.
